To ensure independence, fair treatment, and objectivity, all statistical processing of participant data will be evaluated anonymously. Only the general manager will know the identity of the data author, but not their results; the technical manager will perform the statistical calculations without knowing who submitted the data. All statistical results will be published anonymously, allowing each participant to verify that their data has been correctly processed.

PreaLab is an autonomous and independent company that is not subordinate to any other organization. All of our income comes solely from the fees charged for services provided to our clients. This guarantees that there are no commercial, financial, or other pressures that could compromise the impartiality of our activities.

To prevent any conflict of interest, all PreaLab personnel must inform internally any relationship with clients, whether personal or of any other nature, so that appropriate preventive measures can be taken.

PreaLab proactively identifies any threats to impartiality through mechanisms such as management reviews, the complaints policy, the confidentiality policy, the internal audit program, and evaluation visits from the Mexican accreditation body, with the aim of minimizing or eliminating such threats.
